



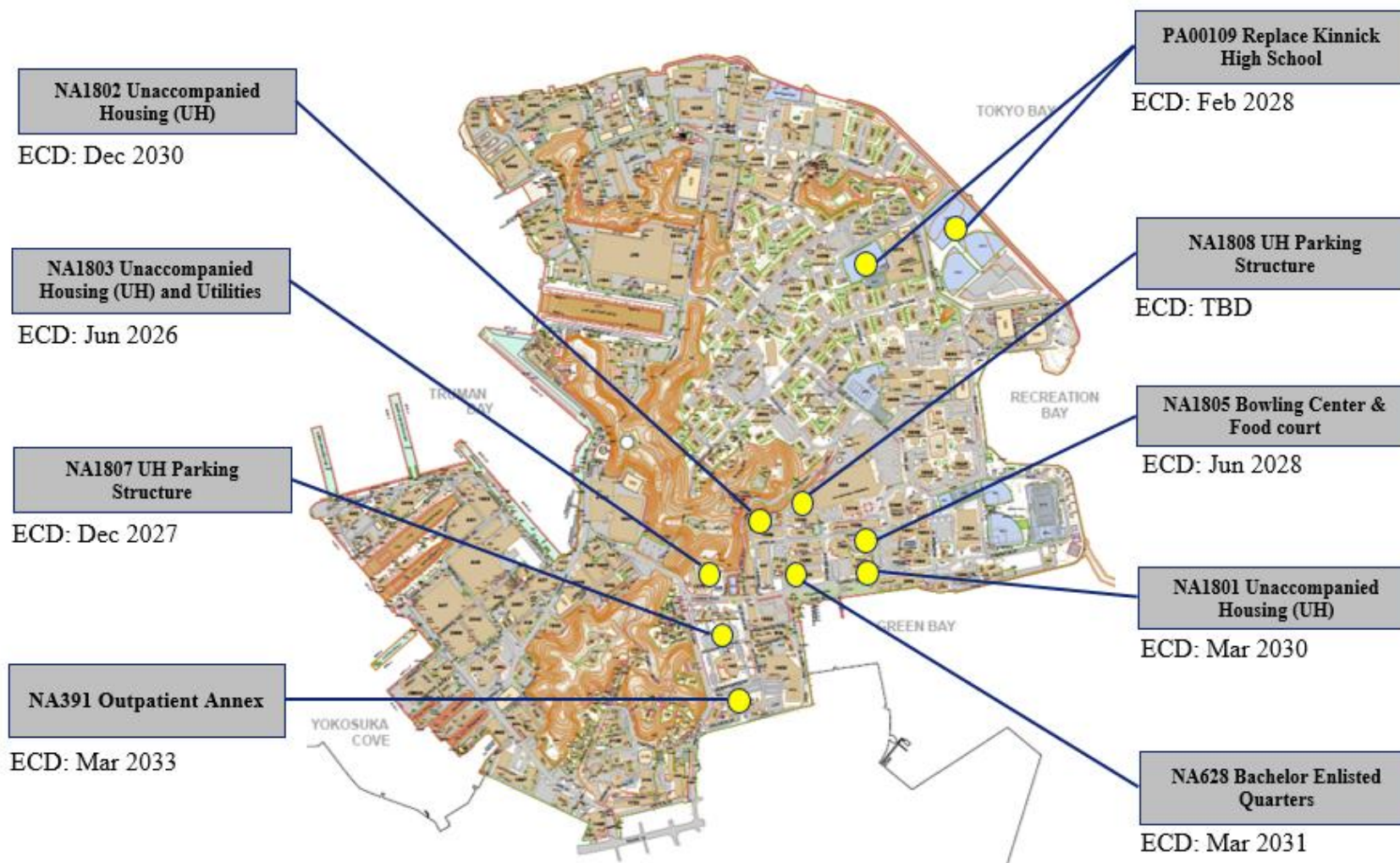

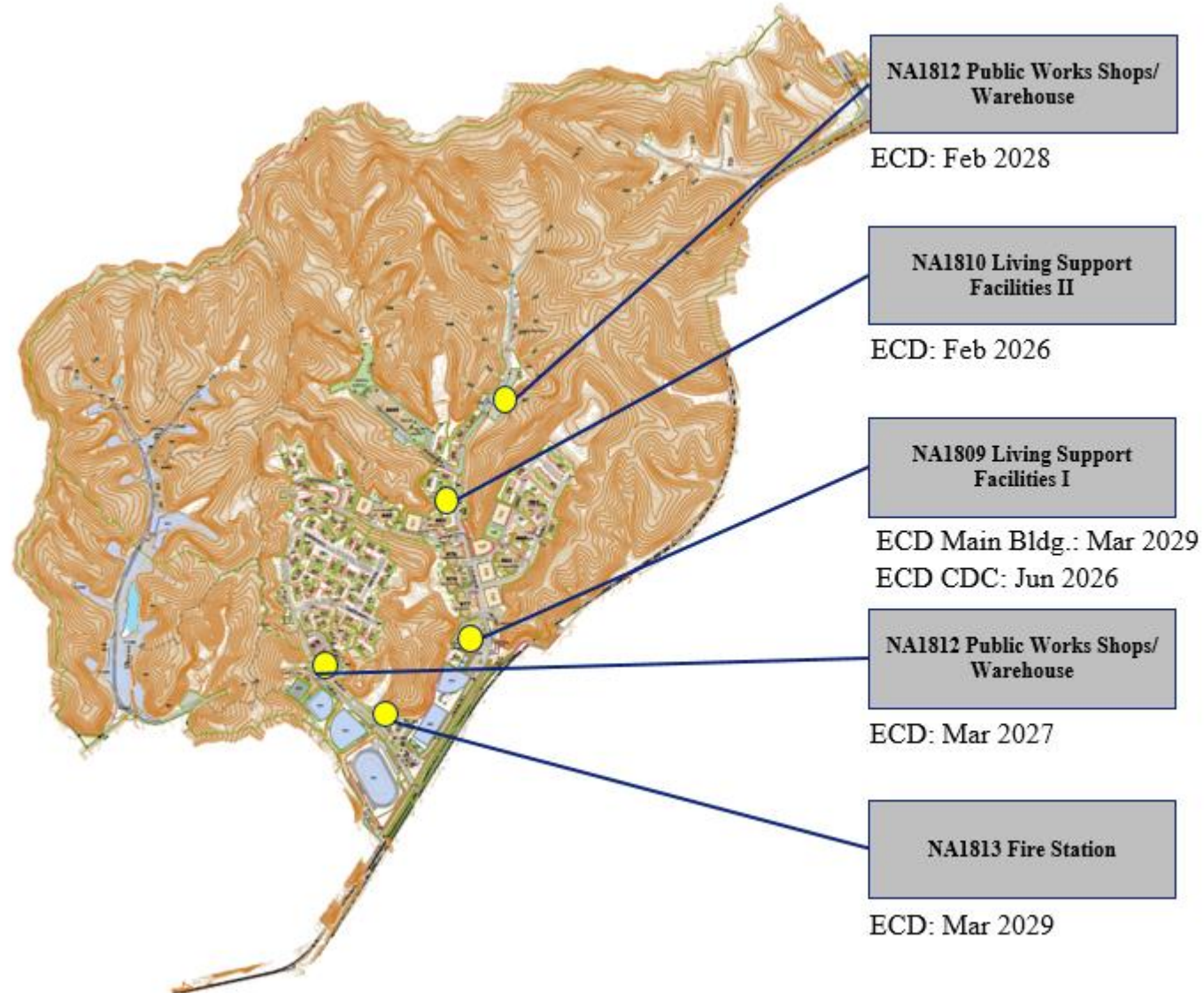

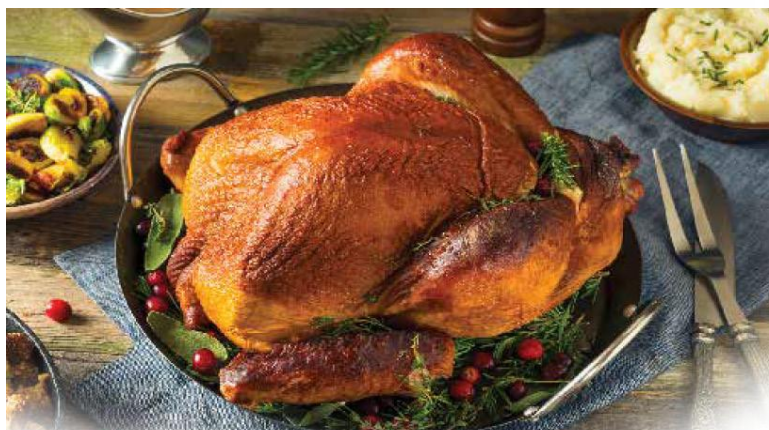

❖ Christmas Decorations

- Christmas lights and decorations are permitted 30 days prior to and 15 days after the event.
- Decorative lights are permitted to be on from dusk until 2200.
- For exterior decorating, use non-destructive methods, not requiring drilling or nailing. Roofs and ledges are off limit areas.

❖ Temporary Absence of Quarters

- **Anyone planning to leave their MFH quarters unoccupied for more than 7 days must contact the Housing Service Center.**
- Complete a “Temporary Absence from Quarters” (form is available from the Housing Service Center).
- House sitting is permitted, but residents remain fully responsible for their individual quarters and House sitter’s conduct.
- House sitters must be SOFA sponsored with base privileges, age 18 and older, and be authorized in writing.

❖ Limited Housing Services During Holiday Period

- **27 December 2025 – 4 January 2026**
- The offices will be operated under limited services due to Japanese holiday week.
- Administrative services (parking certificate, house guest pass request, TLA etc.) only.

Steps to register for AOB Child Care:

1. Contact CDC, SAC, or FCC for availability. Registration must be completed in advance.
2. To process registration for school age children, they must be enrolled in DoDEA Elementary School. SAC programs offer care before & after school during the school year.
3. SAC programs provide full day care for children during the Summer, Spring, and Winter school breaks.

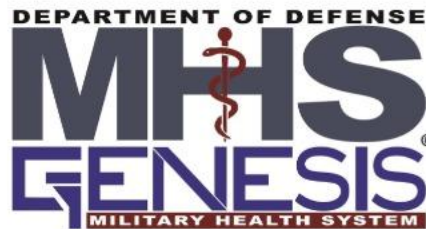

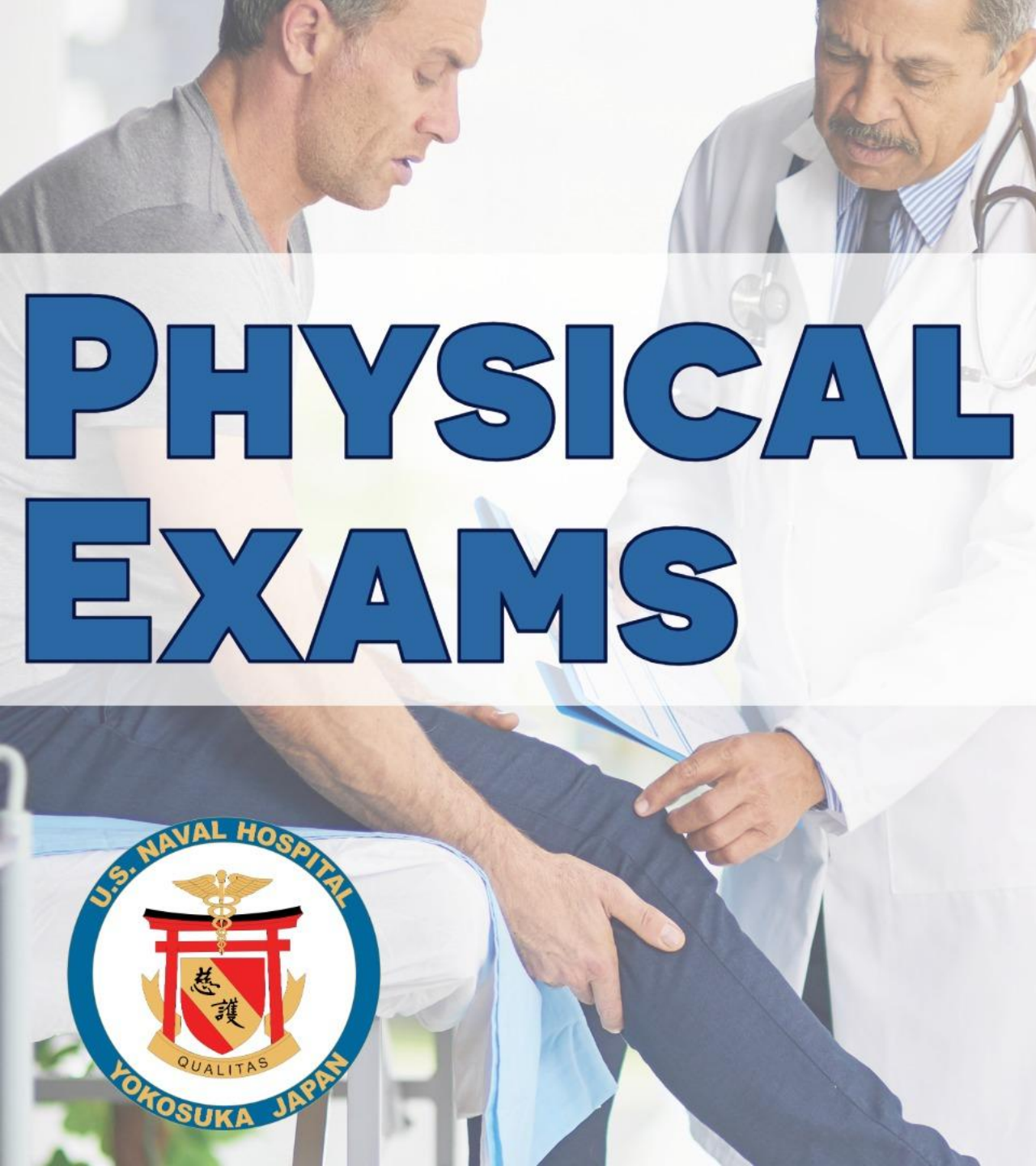

Access to Care for DOD Civilians and Contractors

As a military treatment facility, U.S. Naval Hospital Yokosuka follows Department of Defense policy for prioritizing appointment scheduling. Here's how these guidelines prioritize care:

- Active duty service members
- Active duty family members enrolled in TRICARE Prime
- TRICARE Young Adult- Prime

We are committing to providing care to others whenever space is available after we have honored our responsibility to active duty service members and their families. This includes:

- Active duty family members enrolled in TRICARE Select or TRICARE Young Adult-Select
- Retired service members and their eligible family members
- DOD civilians and contractors

These priorities apply to primary and specialty care appointments. Access to the Emergency Department remains available 24/7 to all DoD ID card holders. All patients, including those receiving space-available care, can have their prescriptions filled through the USNH Yokosuka pharmacy if they are from a licensed U.S. provider and are written in English. (Please note, it may take 1-3 business days to fill prescriptions.)
