NCIS FAR EAST FIELD OFFICE





Mission: Investigate and defeat criminal, terrorist, and foreign intelligence threats to the United States Navy and Marine Corps — ashore, afloat, and in cyberspace.



- **Civilian Law Enforcement Agency:**
 - Jurisdiction to conduct investigations and operations with a DON nexus.
 - DIRNCIS is a direct report to SECNAV.
 - Prevents undue command influence



REFERENCES FOR NCIS AUTHORITIES

- **SECNAVINST 5430.107A (19JUN19): Mission and Function of The Naval Criminal Investigative Service**
 - Enclosure (4)
 - Sec 2 a. NCIS will initiate, conduct and direct independent criminal investigations and associated operations and activities regardless of command authorization.
 - Sec 2 d. Serious Crimes Within the DoN. NCIS has the primary responsibility for investigation actual, suspected, and alleged major criminal offenses to include:
 - Non-combat Deaths
 - Fire or Explosions
 - Loss or Theft
 - Foul Play
 - Criminal operations
- **10 U.S.C. § 7480: Special Agents of the Naval Criminal Investigative Service: Authority to Execute Warrants and Make Arrests**
- **10 U.S.C. § 1585a: Carrying of Firearms**
- **18 U.S.C. § 1385: The Posse Comitatus Act (PCM)** - adopted as federal policy throughout the DON by SECNAVINST 5820.7C (Cooperation with Civilian Law Enforcement Officials), which implements the DoD Directive 5525.5 on the same subject. Both regulations have provisions that exempt some civilian employees of DoD and DON from the limitations of the Posse Comitatus restriction, as long as he/she is not under the direct control of a military officer. **Note:** NCIS is a Civilian Law Enforcement Agency, the NCIS Director is a civilian billet, with direct reporting requirements and daily operational oversight residing in a strictly civilian chain of command. **Thus NCIS civilian special agents are not bound by the prohibitions of PCM.**

UCMJ Art 125 – 18 USC § 1201 /1204 Kidnapping - 20 years


