

MOTORCYCLE ENDORSEMENT; EXPERIENCED RIDERS



You must possess a SOFA License (USFJ Form 4EJ) first before applying for a motorcycle endorsement.

Steps to get a motorcycle endorsement (experienced riders);

You must have a motorcycle endorsement on your stateside driver's license to be considered an experienced rider. If you do not have the endorsement, you are considered a first time rider, so you need to take BRC 1 before taking BRC 2.

If you are taking the class on Yokohama North Dock;

1. Sign up for the Motorcycle Safety Foundation BRC 2 class.

- This is a 1 day class.
- Enroll through the GLOBAL TRAINING tab on the ESAMS website. https://esams.cnic.navy.mil/ESAMS_GEN_2/Login
- All enrollees will be waitlisted until all pre-requirements identified in ESAMS are met.
- Active duty personnel have priority.
- You must have your own motorcycle for this class.



If you are taking the class on Yokota Air Base;

For enrollment, please email Yokota Safety Representative; 374aw.sev3@us.af.mil

Please contact and ask them about their requirements before signing up for the class. Their requirements could be different from Yokohama North Dock class.

2. Come by the Licensing Office after attending/passing the BRC 2 to get a motorcycle endorsement on your SOFA license. Please do not forget to bring your MSF card, Course Completion Records, SOFA license, stateside driver's license, and DoD ID card.
